Mouths Wide Open

When was the last time you peeked inside your dog's mouth? Not just a quick look, but a close inspection of the palate, gums, and all those soft, pink surfaces.

If you're thinking, "I never even thought of doing that," consider the fact that about 1 in 20 dogs with oral tumors gets lesions in his mouth first. People rarely look for early signs such as discolorations and tiny bumps and lumps and these lesions often go unnoticed. Delays in detection make oral tumors difficult to treat, so be sure to do a spot check whenever you brush your pet's teeth.
